

Cookies Policy

Use of cookies and browsing data by our Website

Our Website uses cookies which are small information files sent by a web server (like the one we use to run our website) to an individual's computer. These files are then stored on the computer's hard drive. The information contained within the file is sent back to the server each time the individual's computer requests a page from the server. This enables the server to identify and track the individual's browser. A cookie contains text and is like an identification card which can only be translated by the server it originated from.

Cookies cannot tell us information such as your email address. We can only find out information like that when you tell us, for example if you submit it to us using a "contact us" form on our website.

Our Website uses the following cookies for the following purposes:

First party cookies:

- the country where your computer is located,
- the pages of our Website that were viewed during your visit and
- any search terms that you entered on our Website.

We may collect this information even if you do not submit any information capture forms or make any transactions using our Website, and will use it to administer and improve the accessibility of our Website, for internal operations (including troubleshooting, analysis of how our Website is used, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes) and as part of our efforts to keep our Website safe.
